

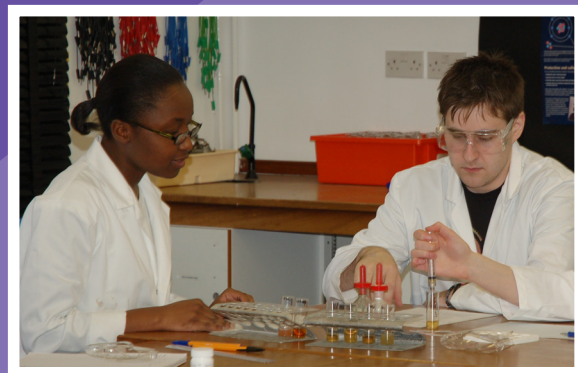

remission of fees

The following groups of people qualify for remission of tuition fees and only pay a £20 registration fee per subject, however, this may be subject to change.

- unemployed people in receipt of Jobseekers' Allowance or Employment Support Allowance.
- students aged 19-25 years who are working towards their first full Level 3 qualification.
- students over the age of 25 who do not have a full Level 2 qualification but are working towards their first full Level 3 qualification.

Evidence must be produced to show your eligibility.

Students aged 16-18 on 1st September 2011 do not pay any fees. Students under the age of 16 are not eligible for concessions.
