Film is an important part of French culture and life, as well as being an excellent way of improving your language. For A Level you will be studying a French film too!

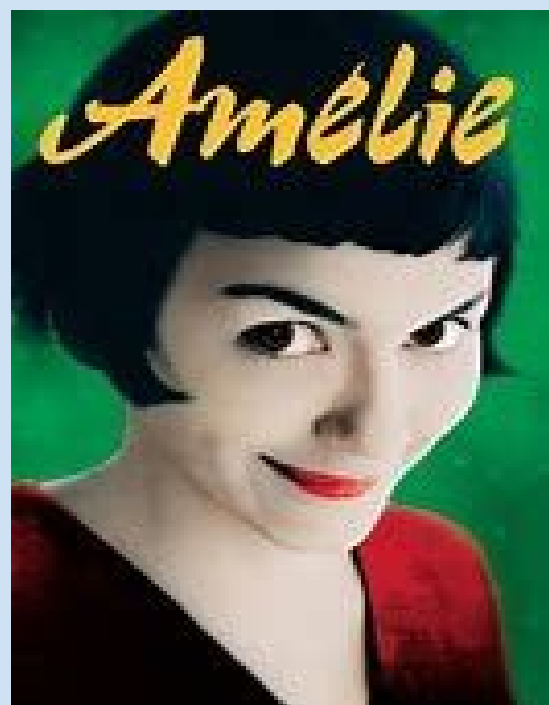

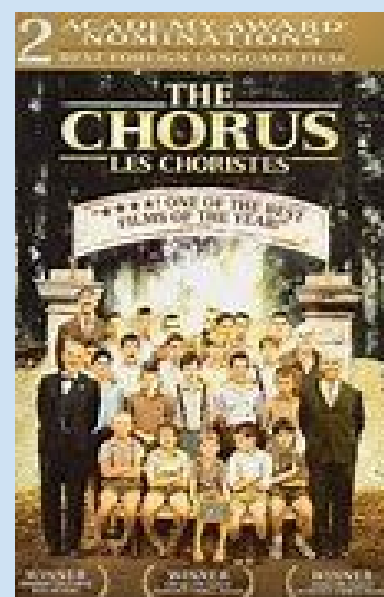
Coco avant Chanel – fashion
